Programme Guidance documents:

- National ERDF Eligibility rules – including rules on who can apply, match funding and eligible activities and costs
- Eligibility guidance – a practical guide with detailed explanations and worked examples
- Selection criteria – requirements for projects including value for money and compliance with procurement, State Aid and publicity rules
- Branding and publicity requirements – including use of the EU logo
- State Aid Law guidance – an overview of State Aid law and where to find out more. It is the grant recipient's legal responsibility to ensure that they comply with State Aid law
- Procurement Law Compliance Guidance Note and Procurement Aide Memoire – all ESIF projects need to comply with Public Procurement Law: this note explains the requirements
- Output indicator definitions guidance – guidance for identifying and monitoring project outputs
- Revenue generating projects guidance – notes on the implications for ERDF projects which generate income and how to calculate the potential net revenue
- Document retention guidance – guidance on record keeping and requirements for retaining documents related to ERDF projects
- Priority Axis 4 Guidance for ERDF - Further information on eligible activities under the ERDF priority to 'support the shift to a low carbon economy in all sectors'
