BBfA is up and running in the HotSW area providing regular advice and business support across a range of legislation (approx. 40k engagements per annum). BBfA encourages inward investment and rolls out a red carpet to businesses thinking of setting up in Devon & Somerset. The BLG confirmed support for the initiative in the HotSW area.
