# Highlight Report No 9 – 25<sup>th</sup> August 2015

### **Reporting period**

August 2015

#### **Summary Comments**

The business case for Somerset Energy Innovation Centre Phase 2 was approved at the August SIP and there has been progress on development of funding agreements and conditions on a number of Growth Deal projects.

A detailed review has been carried out of expenditure forecasts for all GD1 projects. As expected this has shown significant slippage in 15/16 in-year expenditure. However, there has been no issue with 15/16 starts and forecasts show that all projects not already started, with the possible exception of Bridge Road in Exeter, will commence as expected this year.

GD3 project applications have begun to come in, with an earlier deadline for the transport projects meaning 22 projects have come in ready for assessment by the Independent Transport Assessor team. This will need significant rationalisation by the assessors and LTB, since the request totals more than £100m LGF.

### **Growth Deal 1**

Project funding agreements have been produced for the 3 FE capital, 3 business projects and 2 place projects with SIP approval. Agreements have also been produced for the LTB programme entry approved transport schemes. 3 funding agreements are now signed.

Slippage has been identified with a number of projects, as highlighted on the programme summary attached. A separate document also gives a review of progress against original baseline in more detail.

A programme management guide is still in progress but other items have been prioritised. When available this will provide advice on the programme management process to the decision making groups and teams delivering the programme

No change on the outputs targets - target outputs for each project will form part of the project monitoring plan which will be monitored over the life of the programme.

# **Growth Deal 2**

Government reporting now requires quarterly breakdown for 16/17, so includes GD2 spend and outputs. Leadership Groups to respond with profiles by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2015. Work is beginning on a number of GD2 business cases, including: Exeter Science Park – Met Office Environmental Futures Campus, Science Park Centre Phase 2; Growth Hub; Broadband.

The project plan for the Unlocking Growth Fund was presented to the August SIP. This will ensure projects business cases are evaluated, prioritised and approved by the LEP Board in March 2016 for a start in April 2016.
