4.1 Area Based Review	This report sets out the review recommendations from the Gov't series of 'Area based reviews' for Devon & Somerset Colleges, accompanied by a verbal commentary from Stephen Criddle as Chair of our People Leadership Group. The LEP Board notes the recommendations.
4.2 Next steps following Board Away Day	 The LEP should adopt the vision, mission and strategic priorities set out, noting the flexibility required in the areas identified. Under the vision, mission and strategic priorities, a Board working group should be established to establish the detailed operational arrangements for the LEP in adopting these. The Prospectus set out in the Annex is adopted.
