Objectives around Transport and Infrastructure	KR1	<p>Okehampton – Network Rail and GWR preparing business case submission to DfT in Autumn 2020. Potential for train services to start by 2022.</p> <p>Tavistock – Devon County Council awaiting response from DfT to Accelerated projects proposal. Timescale currently unclear.</p> <p>Cullompton &amp; Wellington – Working with Mid Devon, Somerset West &amp; Taunton Councils, Network Rail and GWR to submit Strategic Outline Business Case by end of 2020. Potential bid to next round of DfT “New Stations Fund” in 2021.</p>
	KR2	<p>Lead role on decarbonisation being taken by Sub National Transport Body “Peninsula Transport”. Draft Decarbonisation Strategy to be completed in 2020/21.</p> <p>Ongoing liaison with Train Operators on rebuilding rail services and patronage, and engagement with bus operators through Travelwatch South West and Peninsula Transport Forum.</p>
	KR3	<p>Proposals report was published in July 2020 – partnership working with Wiltshire, Somerset and Devon together with Network Rail, South Western Railway and GWR.</p> <p>Proposals go forward in late 2021 as potential project for the Rail Network Enhancements Programme. If approved, could result in a start on infrastructure improvements c2024.</p>
